A. Browne discussed the previous outreach activities, outreach approach, and community feedback and the website updates of the project.

### II. Design and Construction

A. Metro Parks Improvement:

1. Jason Canuel of Louisville Metro Parks discussed the improvements that are happening in the park.

2. Updates include:

a) Hornung Field has been regraded.

b) The lily pond construction will start in Spring 2019.

c) Harmony field has been too wet to work on, once the weather is dry regrading will occur.

d) The ball house has received funding to be renovated.

(1) Louisville Metro Parks has different options for the ball house. The first option includes having a meeting room, office space, storage closet, and large restrooms. The second option that was presented was an open floor layout that would have an office space, storage closet, and smaller restrooms but more open space for activities.

1. The work on West Broadway will continue. Significant portion of the underground utility work has been complete. Work will continue on the Gate 87 Building (In the park) for the next two weeks. Work on the existing Gate 88 structure will take place In the next two weeks. Work as CSO 104/105 at the end of W. Broadway will continue until April.

2. Brick work is being done to the exposed face of the Operations Building and the Public Restroom and Pavilion.

### C. Upcoming Activities:

1. Basin: Interior clean up and testing. Backfill will continue as weather permits.

2. Underground Control Building: Interior painting, clean up, and testing is occurring.

3. Basin Courtyard: Brick work and concrete paving is being done.

4. CSO 189: Site Restoration is being done.

5. CSO 104/105: Continue concrete work.

6. Targeting to pave Loop Road in April.

### D. Minority & Women Business Enterprise Update:

1. Project continues to exceed goals for MBE/WBE preference. The project commitment is 15% MBE and 6% WBE and our current projection is 17.25% MBE and 7.75% WBE.

### E. Local Labor:

1. Project continues to exceed goals for local labor preference. The project commitment is 76% and our current projection is 82%.

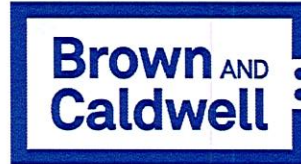



